## **CAPI INCREASES OUTREACH TO REFUGEES & IMMIGRANTS AT HUBBS CENTER FOR LIFELONG LEARNING IN ST. PAUL.**

Minneapolis, MN (October 21, 2009) – Effective November 4, CAPI will have its presence at the HUBBS Center every Wednesdays, from 9 am to 4 pm, to provide job search related services – job clubs, mock interviews, online applications – to refugees and immigrants.

The HUBBS Center is where hundreds of refugees and immigrants come every day to learn English. It also provides educational services to adults who want to improve their basic skills, earn a GED, prepare for employment or post-secondary education.

Liana Nordell, Counselor of Adult Basic Education, conducted a facility tour to introduce CAPI staff to what the center offers and to identify gaps in resources that CAPI may be able to fill. Employment and job search assistance were identified as areas that CAPI could assist.
